## Tucson Classics (Rotary) Car Show

It is time once again to look ahead to the Rotary Show and where you will be on October 19th.

Last year there were 41 British cars in the show with 25 TBCR cars in the featured TBCR row. This year the Rotary staff have again saved us 25 spots in that prime row. At this time the TBCR row has 11 spots remaining, after that, entrants will be put on a waiting list. You need to register soon to be assured of a spot.

#### Step 1 -- Register for the show via this

page: <u>https://tucsonclassicscarshow.com/</u> British cars are in Class Y and it is important that you <u>indicate your club affiliation</u> [enter 'Park with TBCR'] so they can put you in the TBCR row. Make a note of your "Reg. ID" (it will be on the confirmation page and also in the email they will send you) because now you are ready for...

**Step 2** -- Email Geo at <u>ahwahnee18@gmail.com</u> with your entry number & details so they may be recorded on this spreadsheet: <u>http://tinyurl.com/y3nzlbj2</u>. <u>This step is important as</u> only the first 25 on that list will be parking in the featured row.

Other things to know:

- The TBCR tent will be in place for shady seating, kibitzing and unhealthy snacks
- Info about the VIP tent can be found by clicking on 'Classics Club' on the registration page
- 'Early slotting' refers to the option you have to place your car on the show field on Friday afternoon (day before the show)

The show does sell out each year and I expect our TBCR row to fill up long before the show is full so if you are planning to attend, consider registering now. I hope to see you there.

The "Big" Healey became a part of my family in late 1964. My uncle Bobby was particularly interested in this car due to its low production. He found it at a used car lot in Torrance, CA. It had every available option except for the radio. He paid \$2800.

The car was well used over the next decade. It was my aunt "Boots' " daily driver. My early memory of the car is Boots picking up my sister and me for rides. I was about eight and my sister about five. The car is a two seater so my sister had to sit on the spare tire.
